AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology; requiring budgeting in certain categories and amounts; requiring certain performance measures; providing for duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary limitations; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology shall budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
5 upon the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
6 Technology by law shall be set by the Oklahoma Center for the
7 Advancement of Science and Technology. The salary of the Executive
8 Director of the Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and
9 Technology shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
10 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.

11 The Oklahoma Center for the Advancement of Science and Technology
12 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
13 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
14 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
15 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
16 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
