8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Commission for  
10 Teacher Preparation; making an appropriation; stating  
purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
11 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
12 limiting salary of the Executive Director; providing  
budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
13 date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
17 Commission for Teacher Preparation from any monies not otherwise  
18 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
19 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
20 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
21 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher  
22 Preparation by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
2 Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation shall budget all funds  
3 in the following categories and amounts:

4 Preparation and Professional

7 The Commission shall develop outcome-based performance measures  
8 for each budget category.

9 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
11 upon the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation by law shall be  
12 set by the Executive Director of the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher  
13 Preparation. The salary of the Executive Director shall not exceed  
14 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Commission for  
16 Teacher Preparation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall  
17 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
18 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
19 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
20 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
21 Statutes:
