6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to the Corporation Commission;
8 authorizing the Commission to develop plan to promote
9 construction of electrical transmission facilities to
10 develop wind power; providing for distribution;
11 providing for noncodification; and declaring an
12 emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 To promote the construction of critically needed upgrades to
17 electric system transmission facilities in this state and further
18 develop the wind power industry, the Corporation Commission is
19 authorized to develop a plan, including legislative recommendations,
20 to prioritize such transmission development. The Commission should
21 consider proposals based on a cost/benefit ratio and study the
22 possibility of the state issuing bonds to provide a funding source
23 for construction of transmission projects which will benefit the
24 citizens of this state. The Commission shall distribute copies of

1 any plan issued pursuant to this act, to the Governor, the President
2 Pro Tempore of the Senate and Speaker of the House of
3 Representatives.

4 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
