9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the State Auditor and Inspector;
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
14 duties and compensation of employees; providing
15 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective
16 date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Auditor
19 and Inspector from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
20 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
21 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
22 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
23 upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State
2 Auditor and Inspector shall budget all funds in the following
3 categories and amounts:

14 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
15 each budget category.

16 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
17 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law shall be set by the
19 State Auditor and Inspector. The State Auditor and Inspector for
20 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
21 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
22 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
23 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
24 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
