9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Office of the State Bond  
11 Advisor; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
12 and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
13 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
14 providing budgetary limitations; and providing an  
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office  
18 of the State Bond Advisor shall budget all funds in the following  
19 categories and amounts:

1 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
2 each budget category.

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the Office of the State Bond Advisor by law shall be set by the  
6 State Bond Advisor. The Office of the State Bond Advisor for the  
7 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following  
8 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
9 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
10 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
11 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
