8 AS INTRODUCED

9 An Act relating to the Department of Central  
10 Services; requiring budgeting in certain categories  
and amounts; requiring certain performance measures;  
11 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
limiting the salary of the Director; providing  
12 budgetary limitations; and providing an effective  
date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
16 Department of Central Services shall budget all funds in the  
17 following categories and amounts:

5 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
6 each budget category.

7 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
9 upon the Department of Central Services by law shall be set by the  
10 Director of the Department of Central Services. The salary of the  
11 Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
12 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.  
13 The Department of Central Services for the fiscal year ending June  
14 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
15 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding  
16 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
17 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
18 the Oklahoma Statutes:
