9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the State Election Board; making
11 an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;
13 requiring certain performance measures; providing for
duties and compensation of employees; limiting the
salary of the Secretary; providing budgetary
limitations; and providing an effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election
18 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
19 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
20 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
21 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
22 State Election Board by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State
2 Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
3 and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the Secretary
15 of the State Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the
16 State Election Board shall not exceed _____
17 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
18 ending June 30, 2010. The State Election Board for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
20 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
21 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
22 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
23 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
