6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68  
8 O.S. 2001, Section 3607, as amended by Section 7,  
9 Chapter 406, O.S.L. 2008 (68 O.S. Supp. 2008, Section  
10 3607), which relates to the Oklahoma Quality Jobs  
11 Program Act; providing exception to certain limit on  
12 eligibility; specifying requirements for an  
13 establishment eligible to receive certain credit; and  
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2001, Section 3607, as  
17 amended by Section 7, Chapter 406, O.S.L. 2008 (68 O.S. Supp. 2008,  
18 Section 3607), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 3607. A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,  
20 if a qualified establishment receives an incentive payment pursuant  
21 to the provisions of Section 3601 et seq. of this title, neither the  
22 qualified establishment nor its contractors or subcontractors shall  
23 be eligible to receive the credits or exemptions provided for in the  
24 following provisions of law in connection with the activity for  
which the incentive payment was received:

- 1 1. Paragraphs 16 and 17 of Section 1357 of this title;
- 2 2. Paragraph 7 of Section 1359 of this title;
- 3 3. Section 2357.4 of this title; except as provided in
- 4 subsection B of this section;
- 5 4. Section 2357.7 of this title;
- 6 5. Section 2-11-303 of Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 7 6. Section 2357.22 of this title;
- 8 7. Section 2357.31 of this title;
- 9 8. Section 54003 of this title;
- 10 9. Section 54006 of this title;
- 11 10. Section 625.1 of Title 36 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
- 12 11. Subsections C and D of Section 2357.59 of this title;
- 13 12. Section 2357.13 of this title; or
- 14 13. Section 4201 of this title.

15 B. Any establishment which has qualified to receive quarterly  
16 incentive payments pursuant to subsection B of Section 3604 of this  
17 title for a ten-year period shall be eligible to receive the credit  
18 provided for in Section 2357.4 of this title if such establishment:

19 1. Qualifies for the credit allowed pursuant to subparagraph 1  
20 of subsection B of Section 2357.4 of this title; and

21 2. Pays an average annualized wage which equals or exceeds the  
22 average state wage as determined by the Oklahoma State Data Center  
23 based on the most recent U.S. Department of Commerce data.
