8 A Concurrent Resolution rescinding the "Oklahoma
9 Meal"; and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, in 2009, Oklahoma was ranked 49th in the nation for
13 overall health by the United Health Foundation; and

14 WHEREAS, poor diet and obesity can lead to numerous adverse
15 health outcomes, including heart disease, hypertension, and
16 diabetes; and

17 WHEREAS, the "Oklahoma Meal", which was passed in House
18 Concurrent Resolution Number 1083 from the 2nd Session of the 41st
19 Legislature in 1988, includes fried okra and squash, cornbread,
20 barbeque pork, biscuits, sausage and gravy, grits, corn,
21 strawberries, chicken fried steak, pecan pie, and blackeyed peas;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the "Oklahoma Meal" contains 2,700 calories, 125 grams
24 of fat, and 5,250 milligrams of sodium; and

1 WHEREAS, the policies of the State of Oklahoma should promote
2 the health and welfare of its citizens.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
4 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
5 CONCURRING THEREIN:

6 THAT the Oklahoma Legislature hereby rescinds the "Oklahoma
7 Meal" as passed in House Concurrent Resolution Number 1083 from the
8 2nd Session of the 41st Legislature in 1988.

9 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the State Board
10 of Health.
