9 A Concurrent Resolution supporting drop out  
10 prevention awareness; recognizing February 12, 2010,  
11 as "Drop Out Prevention Day" in the State of  
12 Oklahoma; and directing distribution.

13 WHEREAS, the drop out rate in Oklahoma has become unacceptable  
14 and there is a need for action by communities, civic organizations,  
15 local school districts, parents, and teachers; and

16 WHEREAS, parents, students, teachers, school districts, civic  
17 organizations, and communities as a whole should become aware and  
18 involved; and

19 WHEREAS, a "Drop Out Prevention Day" will bring awareness to  
20 individuals, civic organizations, and communities throughout the  
21 State of Oklahoma.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
23 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
24 CONCURRING THEREIN:

1        THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature believes drop out prevention  
2 awareness will allow individuals, school districts, and civic  
3 organizations to become more involved with at risk students.

4        THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature recognizes February 12,  
5 2010, as "Drop Out Prevention Day" in the State of Oklahoma.

6        THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to the Oklahoma  
7 Superintendent of Public Instruction, Chancellor for the Oklahoma  
8 State Regents for Higher Education, and the State Director of the  
9 Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education.
