8 AS INTRODUCED

9 A Concurrent Resolution congratulating the Fort Cobb-
10 Broxton Lady Mustangs for winning the 2009 Class A
11 fast-pitch softball state championship; and directing
12 distribution.

13 WHEREAS, the Fort Cobb-Broxton Lady Mustangs have always been
14 competitive, whether in slow-pitch or fast-pitch softball. The Lady
15 Mustangs were runners-up in the fast-pitch finals in 2007; and

16 WHEREAS, Lady Mustangs Coach Kelly Pierce decided to change his
17 line-up during the 2009 fast-pitch softball championship game
18 against the top-ranked Fletcher Lady Wildcats by sending in Freshman
19 Ashton Lierle to pitch and assigning senior pitcher Adalynn Klugh to
20 the shortstop position; and

21 WHEREAS, the new line-up worked as the Fletcher team, which had
22 faced Adalynn Klugh before, was unfamiliar with Ashton Lierle; and
23 Adalynn's defensive play and at-bat prowess proved decisive.

24 Adalynn Klugh hit the game-winning run batted in (RBI) in her last

1 two championship games, and Coach Pierce's team won its first fast-
2 pitch softball state championship on the same ASA field where his
3 team prevailed in its slow-pitch softball state championship game.

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
5 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
6 CONCURRING THEREIN:

7 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Fort Cobb-
8 Broxton Lady Mustangs for winning the 2009 Class A Fast-Pitch
9 Softball State Championship, its first ever fast-pitch championship.
