6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
8 to refer to the people for their approval or
9 rejection a proposed amendment to the Oklahoma
10 Constitution by adding a new Section 8 to Article I;
11 reserving certain powers to State of Oklahoma and
12 people thereof; providing ballot title; and directing
13 filing.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
15 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

16 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18 the following proposed amendment to the Oklahoma Constitution by
19 adding a new Section 8 to Article I to read as follows:

20 Section 8. Pursuant to the Tenth Amendment to the Constitution
21 of the United States of America, the State of Oklahoma hereby
22 reserves to itself and to the people of this state the powers not
23 delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited
24 by it to the states.

1 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
2 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
3 the following form:

4 BALLOT TITLE

5 Legislative Referendum No. _____ State Question No. _____

6 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

7 This measure enacts a new section of the state Constitution. It
8 enacts Section 8 of Article 1. It reserves to the State of
9 Oklahoma and the people of this state certain powers. These
10 include the powers not delegated to the United States and not
11 prohibited to the states.

12 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?

15 SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,
16 immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file
17 one copy thereof, including the Ballot Title set forth in SECTION 2
18 hereof, with the Secretary of State and one copy with the Attorney
19 General.

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
