6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State  
8 to refer to the people for their approval or  
9 rejection the repeal of Section 1A of Article XXIII  
10 of the Oklahoma Constitution, which relates to  
employment; providing ballot title; and directing  
11 filing.

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE  
14 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

15 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
17 the repeal of Section 1A of Article XXIII of the Oklahoma  
18 Constitution, which relates to employment contracts.

19 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
20 repealer as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
21 the following form:

24 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

1 This measure removes a section of law from the State  
2 Constitution. It removes Section 1A from Article 23. It  
3 applies to employment contracts. It removes the ban on  
4 contracts that require employees to resign from or belong to a  
5 union. It removes the ban on contracts that require employees  
6 to pay union dues or make other payments to a union. It removes  
7 the ban on requiring certain other payments instead of payments  
8 to a union. It removes the requirement that employees must  
9 approve payroll deductions to unions. It removes the penalty.

10 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?

13 SECTION 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall,  
14 immediately after the passage of this resolution, prepare and file

17 General.
