7 A Resolution designating April 6, 2010, "Oklahoma
8 Employee Benefits Day"; extending appreciation; and
9 directing distribution.

10 WHEREAS, National Employee Benefits Day, established in 2004 by
11 the International Foundation of Employee Benefit Plans, is being
12 celebrated on April 6, 2010; and

13 WHEREAS, Oklahoma's state employees and their families have the
14 advantage of being served by the state's benefits office, the
15 Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council, and the Oklahoma State
16 and Education Employees Group Insurance Board; and

17 WHEREAS, the aforementioned state agencies are working together
18 in a unified and cooperative manner to make sure the people they
19 serve have the best possible coverage in health, dental, life and
20 disability insurance; and

21 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council also
22 offers valuable optional benefits such as vision insurance, an early
23 medical alert known as Invisible Bracelet, flexible spending
24 accounts, online enrollment and the OKHealth Wellness Program; and

1 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma has earned a reputation of
2 offering a great benefits package, and the Governor has proclaimed
3 April 6, 2010, as "Oklahoma Employees Benefits Day"; and

4 WHEREAS, National Employee Benefits Day is an opportunity to
5 recognize the positive contributions of our state's benefits office,
6 the Oklahoma State Employees Benefits Council, and the Oklahoma
7 State and Education Employees Group Insurance Board in recruiting
8 and retaining outstanding employees.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
10 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

11 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate designates April 6, 2010,
12 "Oklahoma Employee Benefits Day."

13 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate recognizes the occasion and
