6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution congratulating the Millwood High School  
8 boys basketball team for winning the Class 3A State  
9 Championship; commending Millwood High School boys  
10 basketball head coach Varryl Franklin; and directing  
11 distribution.

12 WHEREAS, Millwood High School has been recognized locally,  
13 statewide, and nationally for creating innovative, progressive, and  
14 result-oriented educational programs; and

15 WHEREAS, Millwood High School boys basketball head coach Varryl  
16 Franklin has coached the Falcons for 36 years, leading them to 12  
17 state titles. In March of this year, Coach Franklin was selected by  
18 the Oklahoma Coaches Association to enter into the Coaches Hall of  
19 Fame. The induction ceremonies will be held July 25 at the Southern  
20 Hills Marriott in Tulsa, Oklahoma; and

21 WHEREAS, the Millwood High School Falcons boys basketball team,  
22 playing in the All City Conference, faced what they believe is the  
23 most challenging schedule in Class 3A, thus preparing them for state  
24 tournament competition which they won; and

1       WHEREAS, the Millwood High School Falcons boys basketball team  
2 ended their season as the most successful boys basketball program in  
3 state tournament history, with at least 10 appearances and with more  
4 state championships than any other boys basketball program.

5       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
6 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

7       THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Millwood High  
8 School boys basketball team for winning the Class 3A State  
9 Championship, their 14th gold ball.

10       THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends Millwood High School  
11 boys basketball head coach Varryl Franklin for winning his 12th  
12 state championship with the royal blue and white Falcons and his  
13 forthcoming induction into the Oklahoma Coaches Association Hall of  
14 Fame.

15       THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Millwood High  
16 School Superintendent Dr. Gloria Griffin, Principal Ricardo Gaines,  
17 Athletic Director Avery Gilliland, and boys basketball head coach  
18 Varryl Franklin.
