6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution congratulating the Sentinel Lady  
8 Bulldogs Softball Team for winning the 2010 Class 2A  
9 State Slow-Pitch Softball Championship; commending  
10 their record; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, if there ever was a day to remember in the history of  
12 Sentinel High School's women's slow-pitch softball program, it was  
13 at the State Class 2A slow-pitch softball state tournament in  
14 Oklahoma City; and

15 WHEREAS, the Lady "Dawgs", as they are affectionately known,  
16 entered the state tournament ranked eighth in Class 2A and as the  
17 seventh seed. The previous week the Lady Bulldogs had lost in the  
18 regional opener where they were runner-up; and

19 WHEREAS, in what was the best single day in its women's slow-  
20 pitch softball history, the Lady Bulldogs were not favored to win  
21 any of the three games they played that day. They played the number  
22 one-, number two-, and number six-ranked teams and outscored them by  
23 a combined total of 53 to 27; and

1       WHEREAS, the Sentinel wins were even more impressive when one  
2 realized that the Lady "Dawgs" defeated the defending state  
3 champions who were top rated all season and seeded number one in the  
4 tournament. The Lady Bulldogs finished the tournament not just  
5 winning gold rings, finishing the season with a 27 to 8 record, but  
6 bringing home the school's first slow-pitch softball state  
7 championship.

8       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
9 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

10       THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Sentinel Lady  
11 Bulldogs Softball Team for winning the 2010 District and Class 2A  
12 State Slow-Pitch Softball Championship, the first slow-pitch  
13 softball state championship in the school's history.

14       THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the 2010 Sentinel Lady  
15 Bulldogs Slow-Pitch Softball Team for battling as an underdog all  
16 season, then sweeping the state championship tournament and  
17 finishing their season with a 27 to 8 record.

18       THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Sentinel Lady  
19 Bulldogs Softball Coach Leland Williams.
