6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution congratulating the Elk City High School
8 boys golf team for winning the State Class 4A
9 championship; saluting team players; and directing
10 distribution.

11 WHEREAS, not even a tornado or the graduation of their top
12 golfer could prevent the Elk City High School Elks from winning the
13 school's sixth team state championship; and

14 WHEREAS, the boy's golf team, led by three freshmen who scored
15 in the 150s, won the state class 4A championship despite the 2009
16 graduation of Senior Tyler Russell, last year's state medal winner;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, the state championship, played at Lake Hefner Golf
19 Club, Hefner North Course, in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on May 10,
20 2010, was temporarily shut down thanks to tornado sirens and winds
21 in excess of 40 miles per hour. The tournament officials shortened
22 the event from 54 to 36 holes; and

23 WHEREAS, despite the weather, the boy Elks, with a team score of
24 617, managed to overtake Guymon thanks to the trio of freshmen, two

1 of whom are too young to legally drive a motor vehicle but not to
2 drive a golf ball on the green.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
4 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

5 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Elk City High
6 School boys golf team for winning the State Class 4A championship,
7 the sixth in school history.

8 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate salutes the entire team,
9 especially the three freshmen whose number included the regional
10 champion and the golfer tied for second place in the championship
11 tournament.

12 THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Elk City High
13 School boys golf team Coach Garrette Mantle.
