6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution congratulating the Silo High School
8 Rebels boys baseball team for winning the 2010 State
9 Class 2A Spring Championship; commending their
10 record; and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, the simply excellent Silo Public Schools in Durant,
12 Oklahoma, are A+ schools, where all the classrooms collaborate by
13 working together across curriculum to achieve goals and enhance
14 learning; and

15 WHEREAS, at Dolese Park in Oklahoma City, the red and blue Silo
16 Rebels boys baseball team won their third straight Class 2A spring
17 baseball championship thanks to the outstanding effort of the
18 seniors on the team who were playing their final high school
19 baseball game; and

20 WHEREAS, during the quarterfinals, semifinals, and championship
21 games, the red and blue Rebels scored a total of 28 points compared
22 to a total of 3 points for their opponents. Although the
23 championship game was close, it was a 3-2 victory for Silo High
24 School; and

1 WHEREAS, the Silo High School boys baseball team ended the 2010
2 spring season with a 39-2 record. The Rebels not only won their
3 third straight spring baseball state championship but were also
4 champs in 2002 and 2005, for a total of five spring baseball
5 championships during this decade.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
7 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

8 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Silo High
9 School Rebels boys baseball team for their outstanding record and

12 boys baseball team upon their third consecutive spring baseball
13 championship and their fifth spring boys baseball championship
14 during this decade.
