7 A Resolution honoring the career of Samuel L. Sibert;
8 congratulating him upon his induction into the
9 Eastern Oklahoma State College Alumni Hall of Fame;
and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, Samuel L. Sibert, a member of the class of 1970 at
13 Eastern Oklahoma State College at Wilburton, Oklahoma, broke all
14 basketball rebound records at Eastern and went on to Kentucky State
15 University where he lead his team to two NAIA national
16 championships. In 1972 he was the first round draft choice of the
17 National Basketball Association (NBA) Kansas City-Omaha Kings; and

18 WHEREAS, following his basketball career, Samuel L. Sibert
19 founded and serves as Chief Executive Officer of the S. L. Sibert
20 Company, a major African American owned utility company. He built
21 one of the largest construction companies in north central Texas
22 with more than 250 employees operating in several states including
23 Oklahoma; and

1 WHEREAS, Samuel L. Sibert was the twenty-sixth inductee into the
2 Eastern State College Alumni Hall of Fame in November 2009. Each
3 year since 1988, to inspire current students, the college has
4 honored a distinguished alumnus who has had a dynamic impact on
5 education, the state, or the nation.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
7 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

8 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate honors the basketball and
9 business career of Samuel L. Sibert, and congratulates him upon his
10 selection as a member of the Eastern Oklahoma State College Alumni
11 Hall of Fame.

13 Sibert and the Eastern Oklahoma State College Alumni Hall of Fame.
