6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution expressing gratitude to Senator Kenneth  
8 Corn for his service in the Oklahoma State Senate;  
and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, Senator Kenneth Corn is completing his final year of  
12 service to the citizens of District 4 in the Oklahoma State Senate;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, Kenneth Corn was born on October 8, 1976, in Poteau,  
15 Oklahoma. He earned a degree in political science from the  
16 University of Oklahoma, where he was a member of the President's  
17 Leadership Class and earned numerous honors and awards. He is  
18 active in many organizations, including the American Council of  
19 Young Political Leaders, the Boy Scouts of America, the Farm Bureau,  
20 and the Oklahoma Cattlemen's Association; and

21 WHEREAS, Kenneth Corn has been a member of the Oklahoma State  
22 Senate since 2002, after previously serving in the House of  
23 Representatives since 1998. He was elected to fill the Senate seat  
24 held by one of his mentors, the late Larry Dickerson; and

1       WHEREAS, State Question No. 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and  
2 effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for a member  
3 of the Legislature to a total of twelve years, and as a result,  
4 Senator Corn will not be eligible to stand for reelection this year.  
5 To date, at the age of 33, he is the youngest person ever to be  
6 ineligible for reelection due to term limits; and

7       WHEREAS, Kenneth Corn has energy and enthusiasm appropriate to  
8 his age, and experience and acumen uncommon to his age. This  
9 combination of characteristics has made him a formidable legislator,  
10 a fierce advocate of the interests of rural Oklahoma, and a force to  
11 be reckoned with.

12       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
13 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

14       THAT the Oklahoma State Senate, on behalf of the citizens of  
15 Senate District 4 and all citizens of this state, expresses its  
16 gratitude to Senator Kenneth Corn for his service in the Oklahoma  
17 State Senate.

18       THAT a copy of this resolution be distributed to Senator Kenneth  
19 Corn.
