13 WHEREAS, James H. Nolen is deeply committed to the accounting
14 and tax profession as witnessed by his professional designation of
15 EA (Enrolled Agent to practice before the Internal Revenue Service),
16 ABA (Accredited Business Advisor), ATA (Accredited Tax Advisor), and
17 ATP (Accredited Tax Preparer); and

18 WHEREAS, James H. Nolen was elected President of the National
19 Society of Accountants for the year 2008-2009.
