7 AS INTRODUCED

8 A Resolution congratulating the Westmoore High School
9 Pom and Cheer Squads; commending Westmoore High
10 School for providing an environment where excellence
11 is encouraged; and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, Westmoore High School, established in 1988, is a four-
13 year comprehensive public high school located in South Oklahoma
14 City, Oklahoma. The student body includes residents of South
15 Oklahoma City and Moore; and

16 WHEREAS, the mission of Westmoore High School is to create an
17 environment that provides the opportunity for all students to gain
18 attitudes, skills, and knowledge necessary to become lifelong
19 learners and productive members of society; and

20 WHEREAS, the Westmoore High School Pom Squad has won its third
21 national title in three years in the Large Varsity Division. The
22 Westmoore Pom Squad is Oklahoma State Dance Team Director's
23 Association State Champion Squad and the Universal Dance Association
24 State Champion Squad; and

1 WHEREAS, the Westmoore High School Cheer Squad was the 2007
2 National Cheerleading Association (NCA) Small Intermediate National
3 Champion Squad and 2007 NCA Camp Top Team. All 20 members were
4 nominated for NCA All-American, and 12 went on to receive that
5 honor; one received the Top NCA All-American Award; and one received
6 the Top NCA Captain Award. The Westmoore High School Cheer Squad
7 won the NCA Best Tumbling Award; three squad members were All-Region
8 Cheerleaders; and one member was selected as 2007-2008 Oklahoma All-
9 State Cheerleader. They also won the Oklahoma Secondary School
10 Athletic Association (OSSAA) Academic Award; and

11 WHEREAS, the 2008-2009 Westmoore High School Cheer Squad was
12 selected as 2008 NCA Small Co-Ed National Champion Squad, as well as
13 NCA Camp Top Team runner-up, while all 16 members were nominated for
14 All-American Honors at camp. Eight squad members were awarded NCA
15 All-American status; one received the Top NCA All-American Award;
16 they won the NCA Best Tumbling Award; they placed third in the OSSAA
17 2008 State Cheerleading Competition; and one was selected as the
18 2008-2009 Oklahoma All-State Cheerleader.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION
20 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

21 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Westmoore High
22 School Pom and Cheer Squads for their complete dominance in the
23 areas of competition from 2007 through 2009.

2 for providing an environment where such outstanding excellence is
3 accomplished.
