6 AS INTRODUCED

7 A Resolution congratulating Taylor Treat upon her
8 selection as Miss Oklahoma 2009; commending her many
9 reigns, competitions, and community service projects;
10 and directing distribution.

11 WHEREAS, Taylor Treat is the daughter of John and Debra Treat of
12 Ada, Oklahoma. She has three brothers: Jerrad, Preston, and Connor,
13 and two nephews, Zackary and Will; and

14 WHEREAS, Taylor Treat began dancing at the age of three at
15 Central Oklahoma Dance Center in Ada, Oklahoma. By the age of ten,
16 she had been accepted into the University of Oklahoma's Ballet Youth
17 Program, the Austin Ballet, and the Houston Ballet. She has been
18 teaching and doing competition choreography at her former studio for
19 several years. Taylor has also played the piano since age ten, was
20 a member of a singing group, and played the trombone for four years;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, Taylor Treat graduated with honors from Ada High School
23 in 2005. She was elected Student Body President her senior year.
24 She assisted in implementing service-learning into her school,

1 making it the first public school in Oklahoma to require community
2 service hours for graduation. Taylor also produced a nationally
3 recognized teen safe-driving program entitled "Project Ignition"
4 which teaches teens about driving safety; and

5 WHEREAS, Taylor Treat is a senior at the University of Oklahoma
6 majoring in Human Relations. She was a four-year member of the OU
7 Pom squad and was named the 2008-2009 squad Captain. As a member of
8 Kappa Alpha Theta sorority, Taylor served as an Executive Officer.
9 She was selected for the President's Leadership Class and has been
10 named to the President's and Dean's Honor Roll; and

11 WHEREAS, Taylor Treat created an event known as "Bowling with
12 the Queens" to raise money for the Children's Miracle Network. Over
13 the past two years, more than one hundred children from the Boys and
14 Girls Club of America have participated in a day of bowling, other
15 activities and recognition; and

16 WHEREAS, Taylor Treat reigned as Miss Ada in 2006, Miss
17 University of Oklahoma in 2007, Miss State Fair of Oklahoma in 2008,
18 and Miss University of Oklahoma again in 2009, and was selected Miss
19 Oklahoma on June 24, 2009. Her platform is engaging students
20 through service-learning; and

21 WHEREAS, Taylor Treat competed in the Miss America Pageant in
22 Las Vegas, Nevada, during the last weekend of January 2010. She was
23 selected as one of the top twelve finalists. Taylor won the \$6,000
24 Quality of Life award, given to the contestant judged to excel in

1 volunteerism and community service. She is the first Oklahoman to
2 receive this award.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION
4 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

5 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates Taylor Treat upon
6 her selection as Miss Oklahoma 2009.

7 THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends Taylor Treat for her
8 reigns as Miss Ada, Miss State Fair of Oklahoma, Miss University of
9 Oklahoma, Miss Oklahoma, and for competing in the Miss America
10 Pageant.
