7 A Resolution declaring April 5-9, 2010, "County
8 Government Week" in Oklahoma; and directing
9 distribution.

12 of government closest to the people and are vital components of the

14 offices of County Assessor, Clerk, Commissioners, Court Clerk,

16 Oklahoma; and

17 WHEREAS, the men and women who serve the public in county
18 government perform their duties in a manner worthy of respect and
19 honor. The service rendered to the people of the State of Oklahoma
20 by the dedicated public servants in county government is
21 appreciated; and

22 WHEREAS, the Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma

2 managerial, and technical assistance programs; and

3 WHEREAS, the Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma is
4 holding its Spring Conference on April 6th - 8th, 2010, at the
5 Biltmore Hotel in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The program will cover
6 numerous issues, such as transportation, legislation, employment
7 issues, and safety.

9 OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
