**Bill Summary**

The measure prohibits an athlete agent from any and all communication with student-athletes who are ineligible to be drafted, with the exception of general promotional brochures. Communication includes in-person contact, telephonic and electronic communication.

HB 1095, as introduced, expands prohibited acts of athlete agents to include communication with student athletes who are ineligible to be drafted.
