The CCS for HB 1460 authorizes the Attorney General or any district attorney to conduct an investigation of persons buying, procuring or possessing child pornography prior to the commencement of any civil or criminal proceeding. The measure also makes it a misdemeanor for a person to conceal, withhold, destroy, mutilate, alter, or falsify any records that are the subject of the subpoena duces tecum.
