Bill Summary

The committee substitute for HB1604 amends what a wholesaler licensee is authorized to do, prohibiting wholesalers from purchasing more than 15% of their total spirits inventory and more than 15% of their total wine inventory from one or more wholesalers each year. The bills requires licensed wholesalers to register prices, purchase and maintain or have on order a 15-day supply of the top 18 brands in total sales of all Oklahoma wholesalers in the last year. The bill adds a subsection codifying severability for the section, Acts Authorized by the Various Licenses, in the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act.
