The CCR for HB 1739 adds new language concerning custody disputes in divorces where there is a history of domestic violence. The measure also authorizes the court to specify supervised visitation, allows for the suspension of visitation under certain circumstances, and makes a provision for the payment of attorney fees and costs for a victim of domestic violence.
