Bill Summary

The measure increases fees for Collision Reports issued by the Department of Public Safety from \$7 to \$10. The fee for a five-year Motor Vehicle Report would increase from \$10 to \$15 and the fee for a ten-year report would increase from \$10 to \$20.

Fiscal Summary

The proposed committee substitute for HB 1784 increases fees for Collision Reports and Motor Vehicle Reports.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 1784 increases fees for Collision Reports from \$7 to \$10. The fee for a five-year Motor Vehicle Report would increase from \$10 to \$15 and the fee for a ten-year report would increase from \$10 to \$20. The Department of Public Safety estimates the additional revenue generated would be approximately \$60,000 annually. All fee increases would be deposited into the Department of Public Safety Revolving Fund.
