Bill Summary

The measure is the product of more than two years of work by the Oklahoma Children and Juvenile Law Reform Committee, which was charged with conducting a systemic review of all laws in Title 10 and prepare a recommended draft to reclassify, update, reform, renumber and recodify the laws relating to children and juveniles. This measure relates to the Children's Code.

The Committee Substitute for HB 2028 is comprehensive rewriting of the Oklahoma Children' Code reflecting the work over the past two-years of the Oklahoma Children and Juvenile Law Reform Committee.

Fiscal Analysis

According to the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) and the Department of Human Services (DHS) which worked extensively with the Oklahoma Children and Juvenile Law Reform Committee and staff over the past two years in crafting the proposed committee substitute, there is no fiscal impact to either agency related to this measure.
