HB 2250, as introduced, increases the fine for persons found guilty of a misdemeanor offense in violation of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act. The measure also authorizes the Director of the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control to purchase vehicles without going through the Department of Central Services, Fleet Management Division.
