Bill Summary

Fiscal Summary

Fiscal Analyst: Mark Newman

HB 2257, as introduced, is amendatory language related to temporary managers in nursing facilities, appointed by the Commissioner of Health. This legislation stipulates that an action against a temporary manager does not accrue until the final accounting of the temporary manager is presented to the Oklahoma State Department of Health (OSDH) and OSDH issues a final order.

Fiscal Analysis

Based on information provided by OSDH, HB 2257, as introduced, will have no fiscal impact on appropriated funds.

Long Term Fiscal Considerations

The temporary manager statutes found in Title 63 require the temporary manager to file a final accounting with OSDH under current law. This legislation holds in abeyance any possible lawsuit against a temporary manager for actions taken during the period of their appointment, until the completion of the final accounting.
