**Bill Summary**

The measure recreates the “Group Homes for Persons with Developmental or Physical Disabilities Advisory Board” in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Act.

**Fiscal Summary**

HB 2282 extends the Group Homes for Persons with Developmental or Physical Disabilities Advisory Board until July 1, 2014. The Board serves as an advisory body to Department for Human Services/Developmental Disability Services Division (DDSD) for the development and improvement of services, care and treatment of residents of group homes subject to the provisions of the Group Homes for Persons with Developmental or Physical Disabilities Act. DDSD is responsible for providing clerical staff support and arranging meeting space for duties affiliated with the Board.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The costs associated with the Group Homes for Persons with Developmental or Physical Disabilities Advisory Board include the cost of travel reimbursement for the members and have averaged \$1931.29 per year for the past five years. This amount is already included in the DHS Budget for FY-11.

**Long Term Fiscal Considerations**

DHS/DDSD has an Advisory Committee on Services to Persons with Developmental Disabilities that is representative of all residential, vocational, and professional service types with provider agencies, families, service recipients and other professional organizations represented within the membership.
