Bill Summary

The committee substitute for HB2292 allows the Adjutant General to spend armory board revenue on furnishings for facilities. Under the old statute, the Adjutant General could only use funds for maintenance, general improvement, and alterations to the facilities. These expenditures are capped at \$300 per occasion and \$2,500 per year.

Fiscal Summary

The Committee Substitute for HB 2292 authorizes the Adjutant General to receive financial donations and expend donated funds or utilize state appropriated funds for mementos, presentations or participation in events designed to promote the interests and relationships of the Military Department or Oklahoma National Guard, specifically, but not limited to, the State Partnership Program. Such expenditures are limited to \$300.00 per occasion and shall not exceed \$2,500.00 annually. The measure also authorizes the Adjutant General to expend armory board revenues for armory furnishings.

Fiscal Analysis

The Oklahoma Department of the Military advises that the expenditures authorized under the provisions of HB 2292 require no additional state funding.
