Bill Summary

This measure amends the responsibilities of the Director of the Department of Emergency Management by adding a requirement that the Director report quarterly to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate as to the balance and outstanding obligations of the State Emergency Fund.

HB 2579, as introduced, requires the Director of the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management to provide a quarterly report regarding the balance and outstanding obligations of the State Emergency Fund to the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate.

Fiscal Analysis

Provision of a quarterly report would be completed using existing agency resources. Thus, in its present form HB 2579 has no significant impact on state revenues or resources.
