HB 2625 amends 47 O.S. Section 14-111 to clarify that the provisions of Section 14-111 do not apply to an operator of a truck or other vehicle transporting horses or livestock if the person was not hired to transport the horses or livestock and the vehicle displays on both sides the words "NOT FOR HIRE"..

The Conference Committee Substitute for HB 2625 relates to weighing motor vehicles. The measure provides an exception to the requirement to possess a certificate containing owner- and vehicle-related information for persons transporting horses or livestock; provided, the person shall not have been hired to transport the horses or livestock and the transporting vehicle displays on both sides in plainly visible letters not less than two inches in height the words "NOT FOR HIRE".
