Bill Summary

The Conference Committee Report (CCR) for HB2658 adopts Senate Amendment No. 1 and restores the Title on the measure, which authorizes state agencies to insure against liability for workers' compensation with CompSource Oklahoma (CSO) rather than requiring state agencies to do so unless as otherwise provided. The CCR also modifies statutory references to CompSource Oklahoma, rather than the State Insurance Fund.

The CCR extends the deadline for CSO to be converted into a private insurance company until December 31, 2011, and extends the termination date of the Task Force on the Privatization of CompSource Oklahoma until December 31, 2012. The CCR also requires the Task Force to examine leaving CSO in its current status. The CCR requires the Task Force to publish supplemental findings by December 1, 2010.

Fiscal Summary

The CCR for 2658 extends the date for the privatization of CompSource Oklahoma from December 31, 2010 to December 31, 2011 and authorizes the task force to consider leaving CompSource Oklahoma in its current status.
