**Bill Summary**

The conference committee report for HB2698 restores the title and enacting clause.

HB2698 creates a section of new law to be known as the Oklahoma Government Website Information Act. This bill requires public bodies to make available on their Internet website on or before January 1, 2011 any:

- administrative rules in which the public body uses to operate;
- proposed administrative rules;
- statutes affecting the public body and the way it operates; and,
- statutes the public may find useful when interacting with the public body.

“Public body” is to be used as defined in the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

**Fiscal Summary**

The CCR for HB 2698 recommends that the Senate recede from Senate Amendments which struck the title and the enacting clause. Engrossed HB 2698 creates the “Oklahoma Government Website Information Act”. The measure provides that on or before January 1, 2011, public bodies shall make available on their Internet website or on a general website the following: Any administrative rules adopted pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, which the public body uses to operate; any proposed administrative rules submitted by the public body pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act; any statutes affecting the public body and its operations; and any statutes the public may find useful in interacting with the public body.

**Fiscal Analysis**

All state agencies have access to the state portal system which, with modifications authorized by the Office of State of Finance, can accommodate the website posting requirements listed above.
