Bill Summary

The Conference Committee Report for HB2710 restores the measure to the Engrossed version which creates a state income and corporate tax check-off provision for the Multiple Sclerosis Society, allowing for a donation up to \$25, beginning for tax year 2010. The measure also creates the “Multiple Sclerosis Society Revolving Fund,” to be administered by the State Department of Health. The Multiple Sclerosis Society helps to mobilize people, provides resources for research for a cure, and addresses the challenges of those affected by the disease.

CCR for HB 2710 creates a checkoff for the Multiple Sclerosis Society from taxpayers’ refunds on income tax returns.

Fiscal Analysis

CCR for HB 2710 provides taxpayers the opportunity to donate up to \$25.00 of their income tax refunds to benefit the Multiple Sclerosis Society. The donations are a checkoff item on both the corporate and individual income tax returns.

There is no significant fiscal impact on state funding from this measure.
