**Bill Summary**

The introduced version of House Bill 2710 creates a state income and corporate tax check-off provision for the Multiple Sclerosis Society, allowing for a donation up to \$25, beginning for tax year 2010. The measure also creates the “Multiple Sclerosis Society Revolving Fund,” to be administered by the State Department of Health. The Multiple Sclerosis Society helps to mobilize people, provides resources for research for a cure, and addresses the challenges of those affected by the disease.

**Fiscal Summary**

HB 2710 creates a checkoff for the Multiple Sclerosis Society from taxpayers’ refunds on income tax returns.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 2710 provides taxpayers the opportunity to donate up to \$25.00 of their income tax refunds to benefit the Multiple Sclerosis Society. The donations are a checkoff item on both the corporate and individual income tax returns.
