Bill Summary

House Bill 2747 requires each teacher education institution give an annual report to the Oklahoma Commission for Teacher Preparation on participation in alternative placement programs.

The bill requires institutions to report annually to the commission the procedures used to inform the public about teacher education programs and how public input is solicited and received for the institutions' plans for accreditation. The report would replace an annual public forum.

Each accredited teacher education program shall document the annual professional development of teacher education faculty members. The commission shall review these reports as part of the accreditation process.
