Bill Summary

The floor amendment to HB2962 makes it illegal for any executor, administrator, trustee, beneficiary or other person benefitting from, acting in a fiduciary capacity for, or otherwise administering a probate, intestate, or trust estate to upon conviction of embezzlement from the estate, receive any portion, share, gift or otherwise benefit from the estate.

Fiscal Summary

The floor substitute for HB2962 prohibits anyone convicted of embezzlement from an estate from receiving any portion, share, gift or other benefit from the estate.
