Bill Summary

The committee substitute to House Bill 3025 creates the Task Force for the Study of Lottery and Gaming Revenues. The nine-member task force shall review lottery and gaming policies in the state, revenues from lottery and gaming accruing to the state and the impact of those revenues on the state budget.

The task force shall submit a report to the Governor, Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate no later than December 31, 2010, and cease to exist January 1, 2011.

CS to HB 3025 creates the Task Force for the Study of Lottery and Gaming Revenues, consisting of nine (9) members which include three Gubernatorial appointees, at least one of whom is a member of the Governor's staff, three Members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker and three Senators appointed by the President Pro-Tempore.

The task force, charged with a study reviewing and evaluating lottery and gaming policies and examining revenues derived by lottery and gaming activity and their impact on state budgets, will conduct its first meeting no later than September 1, 2010 and are to submit a report to the Governor, Speaker and Pro-Tempore no later than December 31, 2010.

Fiscal Analysis

The task force is authorized to meet as necessary and the measure provides for reimbursement for travel expenses associated with the activities of the task force. The amount of travel reimbursement will depend on the frequency and location of meetings.
