**Bill Summary**

The Committee Substitute for HJR1018 creates an income tax check-off provision for donation to the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management. All such donations shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management Disaster Response Revolving Fund, created in the act. The fund shall be budgeted and expended by the Department of Emergency Management to provide grant funding in statewide disaster and emergency phone lines and to provide funds to assist with the 12.5% state disaster relief match.

**Fiscal Summary**

The Committee Substitute for HJR 1018 provides for an income tax checkoff that would allow a donation for the benefit of the Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management (DEM). The measure creates the "Oklahoma Department of Emergency Management Disaster Response Revolving Fund" within the State Treasury to receive monies generated by the tax checkoff. All monies accruing to the fund are appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the DEM for the purpose of providing grants funding statewide disaster and emergency phone lines and providing funds to assist with the twelve and one-half percent state disaster relief match. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of State Finance for approval and payment.

**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure provides an additional funding source that would help DEM meet its disaster relief-related duties and responsibilities.
