**Bill Summary**

The committee substitute for HJR1070 proposes a constitutional amendment to be sent to the vote of the people, amending Article 13B, relating to the Board of Regents of Oklahoma Colleges, amending the composition of the Board of Regents so that the state's regional universities are represented by someone who resides in the county of the regional university's campus, and requiring the Superintendent of Public Instruction's position to be appointed at large by the Governor. The proposed amendment also prohibits anyone who is an officer, president, instructor or employee of any higher education institution from serving on the Board of Regents.

**Fiscal Summary**

The Committee Substitute for HJR 1070 directs the Secretary of State to refer to a vote of the people an amendment to the Constitution modifying the membership of the Board of Regents of Oklahoma Colleges.

**Fiscal Analysis**

In its current form, this measure does not impact the state when considered on an individual basis. However, if the number of State Questions exceeds that which the Election Board can put on a single ballot, the cost of a second ballot to accommodate additional State Questions would total approximately \$400,000.
