Fiscal Analyst: Terry McKenna

ESB 798 relates to existing statutory law which prohibits any state officer or employee who exercises discretionary or decision-making authority in awarding a privatization contract from becoming an officer or employee, for a period of one year, of a business organization which is a party to any privatization contract. ESB 798 provides that in the event of a violation of this provision the business organization shall be prohibited, for a period of one year, from contracting with the state agency in which the state officer or state employee exercised discretionary or decision-making authority.
