The engrossed measure creates the Oklahoma American Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission and revolving fund to assist the Oklahoma Historical Society in preparing for and commemorating the 150th anniversary of Oklahoma's participation in the Civil War.

The engrossed version of SB 1137 creates the Oklahoma American Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission. The purpose of the commission is to work with the Historical Society on preparations for the upcoming sesquicentennial of the American Civil War. The commission will be composed of 12 members, with staff support being provided by the Historical Society. The measure also creates the "Oklahoma American Civil War Sesquicentennial Revolving Fund".
