Engrossed SB 1157 adds vehicles transporting fertilizer, cottonseed, cotton, livestock, peanuts, canola, sunflowers, soybeans, any other raw agriculture products, and any other unprocessed agriculture products as vehicles exempted from oversize or overweight requirements.

Engrossed SB 1157 adds several new unprocessed agriculture products to the list of products that may be transported on roads and highways in excess of the legal load limits under certain conditions.
