Bill Summary

Engrossed Senate Bill 1185 modifies the period of revocation of a driver license for persons convicted of being in actual physical control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Allows the period of revocation for an offense of being in actual physical control within ten years of a previous DUI related offense to be modified after 45 days.
