**Bill Summary**

The engrossed version of SB1365 allows the fees for a resident lifetime fishing license, a lifetime hunting license, or a lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for residents under 18 years of age to be paid for by installments. The entire fee must be received within 3 years and the license will only be issued upon full payment.

**Fiscal Summary**

The engrossed version of SB 1365 allows for certain licenses for persons under 18 years of age to be purchased in installments over time and adds the Land Stamp fee to lifetime license fees.
